

## PLANNING YOUR COASTAL ROOTS FIELD TRIP

The purpose of the fieldtrip is to inspire stewardship through education and hands-on experience. The keys to a successful field trip are planning and organization:

- Once your group has conformed the date of your fieldtrip, discuss travel arrangements with the school based administrator. Transportation arrangements must often be made weeks in advance of need.
- Permission to take young people off school grounds varies with the school district and may require "Field Trip Request" forms to be completed weeks before the trip.
- Securing additional chaperones can be challenging. Recruit chaperones well in advance.
- Investigate as much as possible about the site prior to the trip. Become cognizant of accessibility
  for physically handicapped students, availability of drinking water and toilet facilities, and the
  location of emergency medical assistance nearest the site. As most *Coastal Roots* fieldwork is in
  wetland areas, it may be necessary to take along canteens or bottled water and to make "potty
  stops" before reaching the collecting/planting site and after leaving the site.
- Facilities for eating must also be considered. It may be necessary for students to take along brown bag lunches to be eaten at the site or on the bus. Consult the bus driver before planning to eat meals or snacks on-board.
- Inform guardians and students of the: purpose, date, estimated times of departure and arrival back at school, necessary materials, and any field trip fees. Attached is a copy of the information form distributed to students at Grace King and West Jefferson High Schools before participation in a COASTAL ROOTS tree planting
- Secure Field Trip Permission Forms from all participants and take these along on the trip. Provide a copy of the participant roster with corresponding emergency contact numbers to the school principal (or designee) in case of emergency.

Attached is a sample Field Trip Permission Form distributed to Grace King and West Jefferson High School students before participation in a *COASTAL ROOTS* fieldtrip. It was modified from the FIELD TRIP PERMISSION FORM issued by the Abington (Pennsylvania) School District (http://www.pde.state.pa.us/k12/cwp/view.asp?A=6&Q=55695)

• It may also be necessary to have students and their guardians' complete photo release forms prior to the trip.

## SATURDAY, 13 OCTOBER 2001 GOLDEN MEADOW, LA

WE WILL BE LEAVING GRACE KING FOR APPROXIMATELY 6:45 AM AND MAKING A STOP AT WEST JEFFERSON HIGH SCHOOL TO PICK UP OUR FELLOW TRAVELERS.

Afterward, we will clean up and head for home. We should be back at our respective schools for approximately 1 or 1:30 pm. We will make arrangements for enjoying a tasty lunch to eaten on our bus ride home.

The Science Society will provide the breakfast items, snacks, and a light lunch. Dr. Blanchard will be providing cold drinks. The *Coastal Roots* grant will pay for the bus. You, therefore, will need no spending money. You will need:

- To complete and return your fieldtrip permission form.
- To complete and return the photo release form (LSU Sea Grant plans to put pictures of you on their website and the Times Picayune may feature you, too.)
- Old socks and shoes (They will get wet and muddy).
- Dry shoes and socks for the trip home.
- Old clothes- Long pants help protect your legs if you kneel while planting
- Rain gear- If there is a little rain, we will still plant. If the forecast is for really bad weather, we will postpone the trip. Be sure to include your phone number on the permission slip, so that we can notify you of any changes.
- A towel, if you want to dry off after we clean-up (probably hose off)
- Gardening gloves if you have them
- A hat and sunscreen
- Bug spray

Dr. Blanchard will bring each of us a *Coastal Roots* T-shirt. Please be sure to indicate your size choice on the signup sheet.
