\* Note: "Selection of the projects nominated per basin will be by consensus, if possible. If voting is required, each officially designated parish representative in the basin will have one vote and each federal agency and the State will have one vote." [PPL 17 Selection Process, Section II (B)]. The voting process will be a ranked vote. Each agency and parish representative will be given a specific number of votes (matching the number of competing projects in that basin); they are to award their highest ranking PPL 17 project nominee the highest number of points, the next highest one less, and so forth, to the lowest nominee that receives 1 point. The points (votes) for each project will be totaled. The two nominees per basin (three in Barataria and Terrebonne) and the six demonstration projects receiving the highest number of points will be reported to the Technical Committee for their selection of PPL 17 candidate projects on March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2007.
