MEETING PURPOSE:

To select PPL 20 nominees from the list of projects proposed during the PPL 20 Regional Planning Team (RPT) meetings held on January 26th, 27th, and 28th, 2010. The CWPPRA Agencies and Participating Coastal Parishes will vote to select 20 nominee projects as described below.

2. Explanation of Procedures / Announcements



Explanation of Procedures-General

- Initial Regional Planning Team (RPT) meetings took place Jan. 26-28, 2010 to accept project nominations under PPL20.
- Parishes were expected to identify voting representatives during or prior to the RPT meetings.
- This coast-wide voting meeting is being held to conduct voting by basin, when necessary, with the end result being a list of 20 nominees and 6 demos for PPL20
- Paper ballots will be provided to each designated voter in each basin

Explanation of Procedures-Ground Rules

- Nominees will be selected by consensus, if possible
- No voting will be necessary for Mississippi River and Atchafalaya Basins and for Demonstrations
- If voting is required, each officially designated parish representative in the basin and each Federal agency and the State will vote
- Eligible voters will rank the highest number of points in each basin, the next highest one less, and so on, with the lowest ranking project receiving one point (voters must assign a point score to all projects)
- If a tie occurs in any

COAST-WIDE VOTING MEETING OVERVIEW

PROCEDURES for PPL 20 COAST-WIDE VOTING:

- Project proposals or changes will NOT be made during the meeting
- Public comments on projects will NOT be accepted during the meeting
- Voters rank projects by each basin from highest to lowest, giving highest value to highest priority project.
- Voting sheets for all basins will be collected between 9:30 am and 10:30 am.
- Votes will be tallied and sorted for all basins after all voting sheets are collected.
- Projects with the highest resulting scores will be selected as PPL 20 nominees as follows for each basin:
 - 3 in Terrrebonne, Barataria, and Pontchartrain Basins;
 - 2 in Breton Sound, Teche/Vermilion, Mermentau, Calcasieu/Sabine and Mississippi River Delta Basins;
 - 1 in Atchafalaya Basin.
- All four demo project proposals qualify and are automatically nominees.
- Voting results will be presented during the meeting and posted on the Breaux Act News Flash

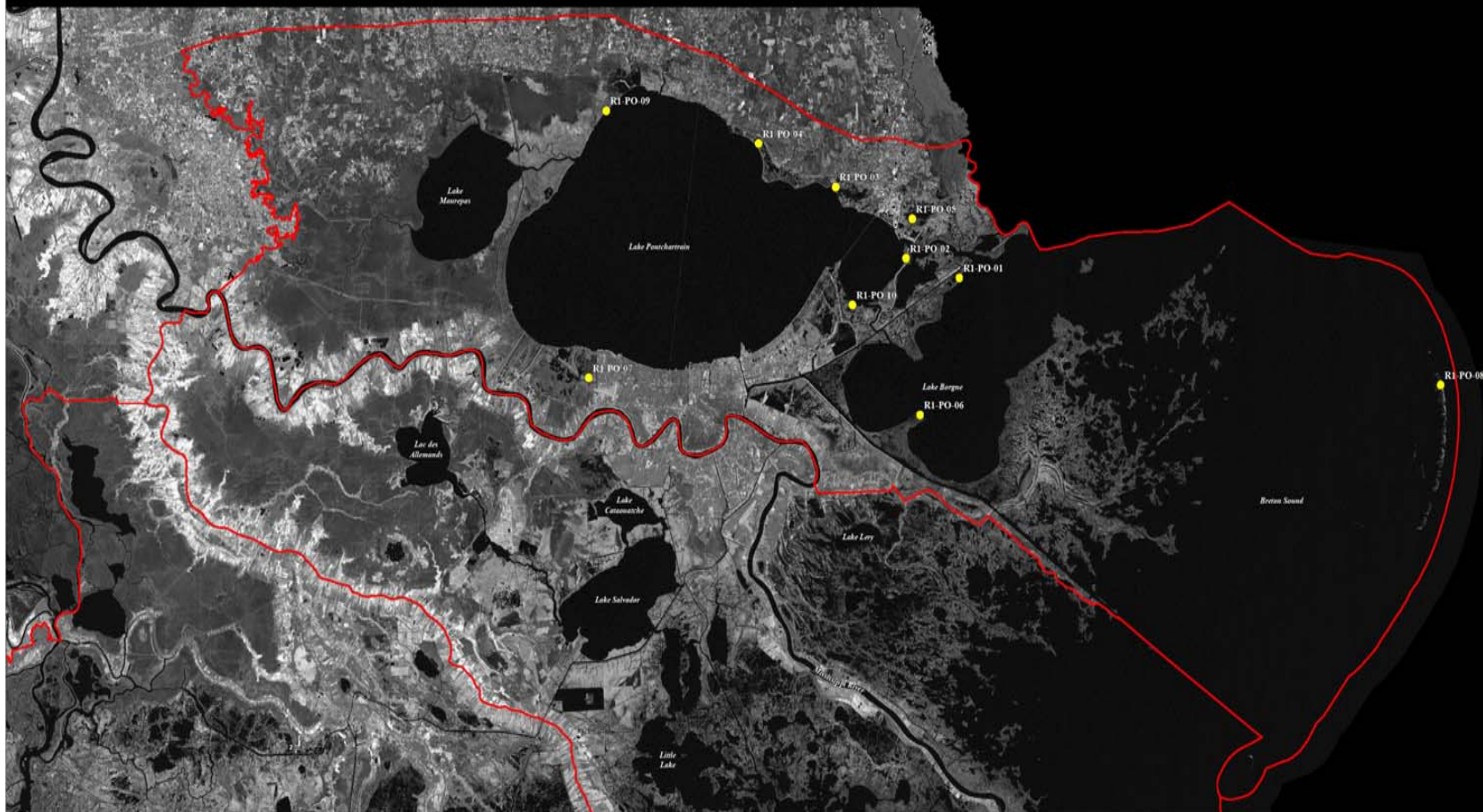

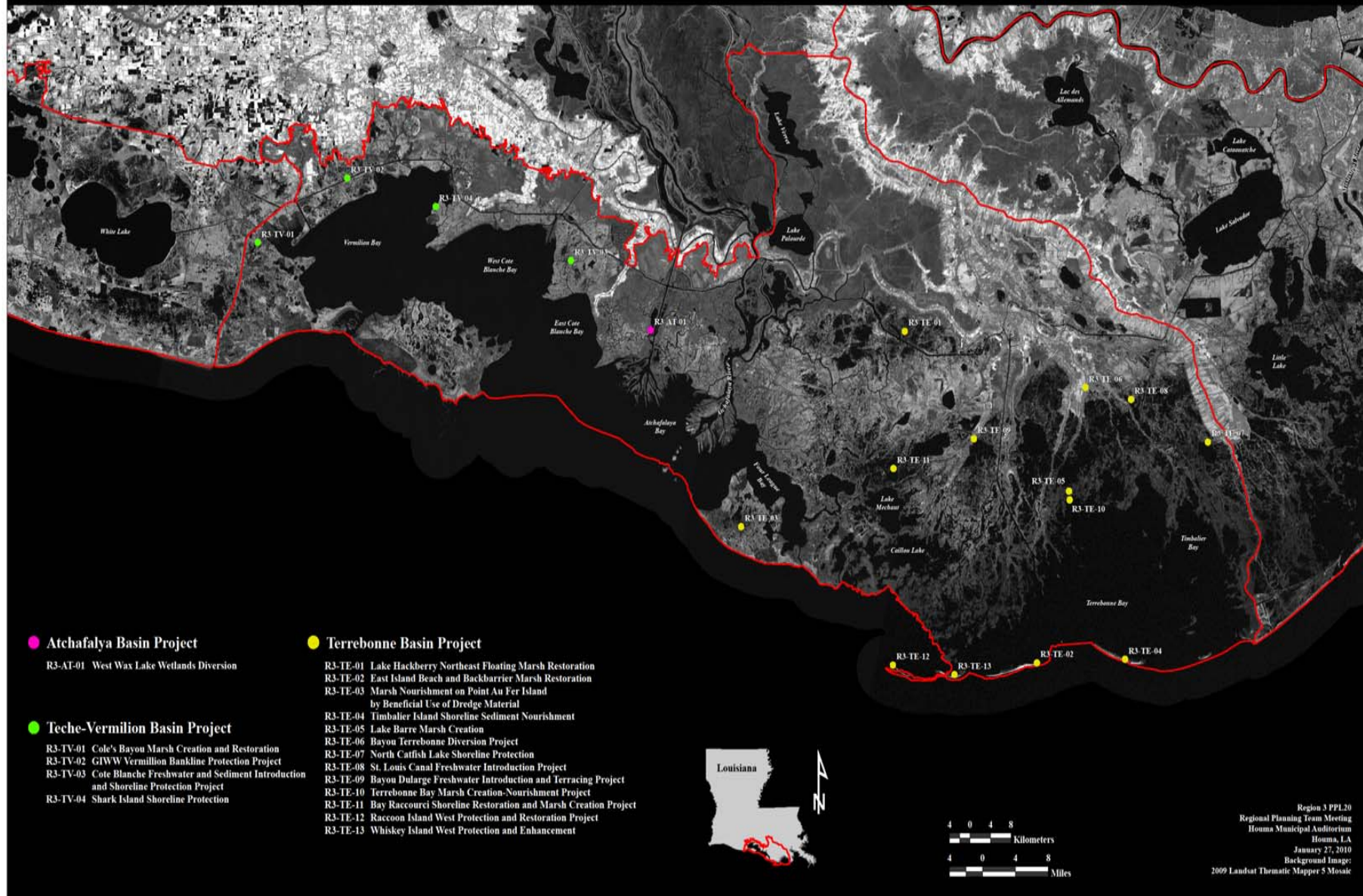
